Monthly costs: € 220.-- to € 470.-- (depending on how much comfort the recipients of grants want). An administration fee of € 18.-- per month is payable to the OeAD-GmbH for arranging accommodation. The costs for insurance and accommodation have to be paid out of the grant by the recipient of the grant. Austria additionally pays the travel costs up to max. € 1460.

Advice on how to apply:	The grants are mainly intended for candidates who are studying, pursuing research or teaching in Japan at the time of application. An extension is possible once for 12 months. Scholarship holders are not allowed to take up paid work in Austria while receiving an OeAD scholarship.

Reporting commitment: Every scholarship holder is obliged to prove that the scholarship was used in an appropriate manner by submitting a final report at the responsible OeAD Regional Office at the end of the scholarship stay.

Selection procedure: Pre-selection is made by national authorities, final adjudication by the Austrian side.

Grant contract:

The recipients of grants will get the grant contract (Letter of Award and Letter of Acceptance) from the OeAD-GmbH/ICM.
